

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Show that –23 is a rational number by expressing it as a fraction in the form  $\frac{p}{q}$  where p and q are integers.




Show that 55 is a rational number by expressing it as a fraction in the form  $\frac{p}{q}$  where p and q are integers.

15	Kayla says " $-3\frac{3}{4}$ is not a rational number, because it is negative and it is not a fraction."  Explain whether or not Kayla's statement is correct, including explaining any mistakes.	Explanations will vary.  Example answer: Kayla is incorrect, because $-3\frac{3}{4}$ can be written as the improper fraction $-\frac{15}{4}$ , which can be shown as the ratio of two integers, so it is rational.	6.NS.C.6

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
